Date:

Sunday, June 13th-Friday, June 18th, 2021

Who:

First-come-first gets to serve.

- Current high school students (2020-21) may register beginning 11/6/20.
- Incoming Freshmen (school year 2021-22) may register beginning 11/11/20.

Where:

We will know closer to the date of the trip but typically we stay at area churches, schools, or community centers and sleep on floors. A sleeping bag with a floor pad or air mattress is recommended. All females and males sleep in separate rooms, including married adult leaders. Showers are available either on site or at a nearby location. Registrants will receive a complete list of what to bring as we get closer to the trip.

Serve

Cost:

Total cost for the trip will be \$650 per student. If you were registered to attend the 2020 mission trip and you have enough rollover in your account, you can choose to use that towards your deposit. A \$100 non refundable deposit (part of the total cost) is required at registration for NEW students.. Each individual student's cost can be reduced through participation in fund raising events in the months prior to the trip. Funds raised beyond the cost per student for this trip may be applied to a future LOC mission trip within 2 years, shared with a sibling, another mission trip student, or donated to the larger youth mission trip fund for scholarships. Excess funds donated cannot be refunded to the student or donor.

What's Included:

The price includes everything...travel, housing, food (we will make and cook it), YouthWorks staffing, chaperone expense, ministry supplies, devotion book, t-shirt, and all activities until the return to LOC. You may provide some spending money, but it should be minimal.

Trip Leaders:

Our group will be led by adult LOC Senior High ministry leaders and YouthWorks staff. We will partner with local organizations to minister to the city and nearby locations.

Register:

Use the LOC app or website (locchurch.com/signup) to register and pay your deposit. You cannot register without the deposit.

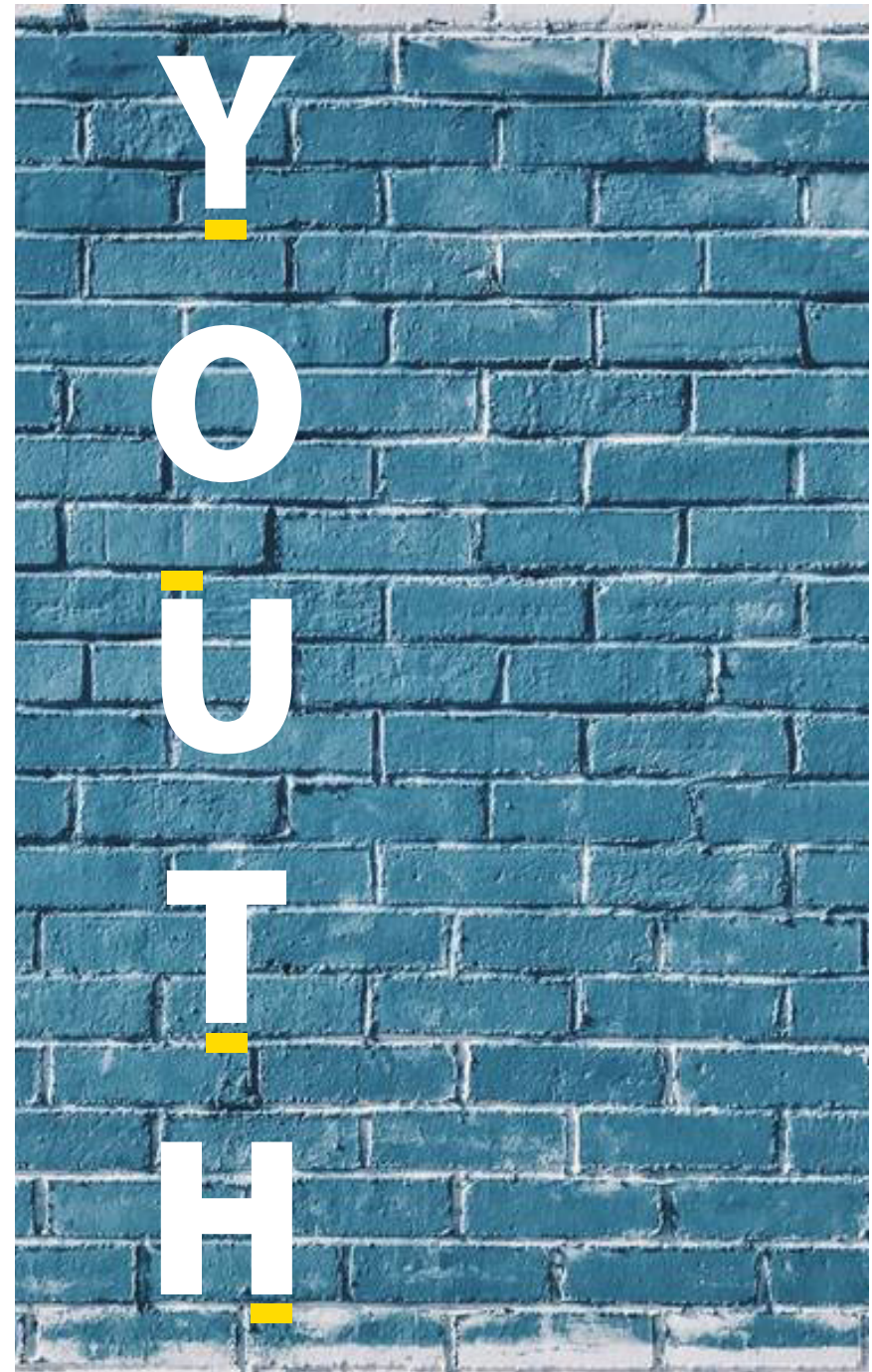
