# LOC Children's Choir <u>Musical Guidelines</u>

This is going to be a wonderful production and I am so happy and blessed that you are a part of it. Thank you in advance for your participation and kind spirits as we go ahead into this journey together. I ask that you and your child/children make a meaningful commitment to our show. The following are some guidelines to consider as we get started!

1. There is a mandatory parent meeting Wed.Oct 3rd, 5pm. It will last about 15 mins. If a parent cannot attend, another adult (i.e. grandparent) may attend to take notes to pass along.

2. Rehearsals are Tuesdays from 4:30-6:00. Please be ready to commit to this time every week. If you anticipate being late or needing to leave early, please let me know via email. Missed rehearsals should be communicated via email as well.

3. When possible, please consider coming to choir rehearsals on Wednesdays from 5:00-5:45. <u>This is not mandatory</u>, but encouraged as it is the best way to learn the songs for the show.

4. Please help your kids hold on to their scripts. **Scripts need to come to every rehearsal**, along with a pencil and highlighter, this is very important. Bring them on Weds. as well.

5. All actors are going to need help with their lines, even the older kids. It will not be enough to let the kids read the script on their own. Even if lines are memorized, it's very hard to know *when* to say them in a scene without someone reading along occasionally. Pay attention to memorization deadlines given at rehearsals please! If a child misses a rehearsal because of sickness, he/she is still responsible to meet the next memorization deadline.

6. It takes a lot to put on a show! Please plan on serving in some way to make the show possible, and to create a safe, fun, and memorable time for all the kids! The "needs list" for volunteer opportunities will be sent out soon for your consideration.

7. We love to offer our Children's programming at no cost to our families, however I may ask for you to search your home for costume ideas for your child/ children.

8. It is *very* important for every actor and choir member to be at the dress rehearsal in its entirety. <u>This is mandatory, even if your child only has one line or NO lines</u>.

9. <u>All important announcements will be made via email. Please make a meaningful</u> <u>commitment to keeping up with the weekly announcements.</u>
